 provision of specialist teaching, training and learning for students across a number of disciplines and will be a fully
 digitised space where students can benefit from advanced lab facilities that mirror industry standards.
- Aberdeen Sports Village, located just across the road from the main campus, provides outstanding sports and
 exercise facilities, including a 50 metre Olympic swimming pool, a 25 metre Olympic diving pool, a full-sized 3rd
 generation FIFA approved indoor football pitch and exclusive memberships for students.
