(For courses and/or research project in a lab)

The home school nominates the student per email to the Student Exchange Office using the template provided (Excel sheet).

Nomination & application deadlines for courses and/or research project*

(Nomination should arrive before the student applies)

*Students doing a project in a lab can apply 2 months before the beginning of the project (4 months if the student needs a visa)

Courses registration Online registration for your courses no later than 2 weeks after the semester starts. Registration opens in August for the autumn semester and

in December for the spring semester.

Language of instruction Bachelor classes are taught in French and to some extent in English.

The offer varies from one section to another. Master courses are mainly

taught in English.

Language requirements Based on the language of instructions of the courses, it is strongly

recommended to have a B2 level in French and/or in English.

No certificate is required.
