Academic Year: Fall semester (September – December/January)
Spring semester (February – July)

Nomination deadlines: Fall semester (Bachelor and Master): 15 April 2023
Spring semester (only Master): 15 October 2023

Application deadlines: Fall semester (Bachelor and Master): 1 May 2023
Spring semester (only Master): 23 October 2023

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

English courses: IELTS minimum 6.5 on all components, TOEFL (PBT 575 / CBT 232 / iBT 90).

Exceptions: Students who finished or are enrolled in a bachelor's or master's program completely taught in English in one of the following countries: Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, the UK or the US. The exception also applies to students who hold the nationality of one of the above-mentioned countries.

Dutch courses: NTII language certificate

BACHELOR EXCHANGE

Bachelor exchange is only possible in the Fall semester (September – December/January).

ESHPM offers three courses in the fall semester for incoming Bachelor exchange students. These courses are all taught in English. Students can also choose to follow the overarching minor program Smarter Choices for Better Health (30 EC).

For students who command the Dutch language at NTII level, it is possible to take courses in Dutch as well.
