Nomination Criteria & Required documents

Undergraduate Students:

- Sophomore or junior standing, enrolled full-time at the time of application
- CGPA 3.0 or above
- English Proficiency level equivalent to IELTS 6, TOEFL iBT 79, , DET 105, CET6 470

UG Seniors who wish to do research:

- Must have fully completed their courses, letter from advisor/Registrar is required.
- CGPA 3.25 or above
- CV
- English Proficiency level equivalent to IELTS 6.5 , TOEFL iBT 91, DET 115, CET6 500

PG Students:

- CGPA 3.25 or above
- CV
- English Proficiency level equivalent to IELTS 6.5, TOEFL iBT 91, DET 115, CET6 500

UAE Visa & Health Insurance

Khalifa university will provide and cover visas and health insurance for all inbound students.

Orientation Guide

Inbound students must attend an international orientation event. Details will be sent by email for accepted students.

Living Expenses

Exchange students are waived from tuition fees, student services fees and application fees to KU. Incoming students will be required to pay a security deposit, before arrival. It is recommended that students budget at least 800 AED (200-250 USD) for their first week here to cover:
