## General Information

<b>Exchange Programs</b>	Offered to Students of Partner Universities 1. <b>Semester Exchange</b> (C: Course Taking) : Spring/Fall semester, credit transfer 2. <b>C + R Combined</b> (R: Research Participation) : Term may overlap and/or be continuous
<b>Research Participation</b>	Students are required to navigate and contact their POSTECH advising professor-to-be directly and receive official approval prior to the application process.
<b>Maximum Period of Exchange</b>	1 academic year (2 semesters)
<b>Compulsory Medical Insurance</b>	Students are required to purchase a <b>separate insurance plan</b> that covers most illnesses and injuries and is valid for <b>at least 1 month</b> from the student's arrival in Korea.  Additionally, as of March 2021, <b>all international students in Korea will be automatically registered to the <a href="#">National Health Insurance Service (NHIS)</a>, effective from the date of their alien registration (most likely done within during the orientation week)</b> . All will be able to receive equal medical benefits as Korean nationals, receiving automatic discounts for doctors' appointments and prescription drugs. Exchange students will receive monthly invoices by post, and the cost will be <b><u>approx. 70,000 KRW/month.</u></b>

<b>University Account</b> (HEMOS / POVIS)	Students will be asked to create a HEMOS account on POVIS with their Student ID number issued within a month of admission. It will be their email account, means for course registration, and will grant access to the university's system throughout the program.
<b>On-Campus Housing</b>	All international students willing to live on campus are guaranteed a room in POSTECH student dormitories. * <i>Specific costs will be specified in the upcoming pages.</i>

<b>Nomination Deadline</b>	<p><b>Spring: ~ September 1</b></p> <p>A specific Excel template will be sent to program coordinators in the beginning of the previous month.</p>
<b>Online Application Deadline</b>	<p><a href="#">Application Website</a></p> <p><b>Spring: After Nomination Screening ~ September 20</b></p>
<b>Final Application Submission</b>	<p><b>The PDF file of the application must be sent to POSTECH by home university coordinator.</b></p> <p><b>Spring: ~ October 1</b></p>

<b>Admission Announcements</b>	<p><b>Fall: within June</b></p> <p><b>Spring: within November</b></p> <p>Students will be receiving specific instructions and the <b>Certificate of Admission</b> along with other documents needed for (D-2) visa applications.</p>
<b>Welcome Packet from ISSS</b>	<p>Students will receive <b>Important Announcements</b> emails from ISSS regarding Student Visa, Housing, Insurance, Student IDs, and will also be asked to continue to liaise with the coordinators for further information on life</p>

	before/at POSTECH (POVIS, Course Registration, Orientations, etc.).
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## **Student Visa & Immigration**

<b>Certificate of Admission</b>	The main document for visa applications. In order for students to receive this in time, their <b>passport must be valid and cover the whole period of exchange</b> upon online applications.
<b>Visa Applications</b>	Credit Transfer: <b>Exchange Student (D-2-6)</b> The process is convenient than others as POSTECH is an <a href="#">IEQAS/Certified University</a> . But, students are strongly recommended to contact the nearest Korean embassy/consulate and check if additional documents were to be needed.
<b>Medical Check-Up Requirement</b>	Proof of a tuberculosis check-up ( <b>in English</b> ) is required for all students from high-risk countries* upon arrival.  *Nepal, East Timor, Laos, Russia, Malaysia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Sri Lanka, Uzbekistan, India, Indonesia, China, Cambodia, Kyrgyzstan, Thailand, Pakistan, Philippines, Nigeria, Republic of South Africa, Belarus, Mozambique, Moldova, Azerbaijan, Angola, Ethiopia, Ukraine, Zimbabwe, Kazakhstan, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Kenya, Papua New Guinea, Tajikistan, Peru (as of April 2020)
<b>Alien Registration</b>	During the orientation period, ISSS will guide students to the Pohang Immigration Office to apply for their Alien Registration Cards (ARC), which will be the official means of identification during their stay in Korea.
<b>Staying in Korea</b>	All students are asked to carry their ARC at all times when in Korea, and will be asked to return it at airport immigrations upon departure.  <b>Students must leave Korea within 30 days from the last day of the program</b> (due to completion of purpose of stay), regardless of their visa expiration dates. Once students leave the country in that month, some nationalities will not be able to re-enter without a new visa.
<b>Are exchange students allowed to work?</b>	<b>On-Campus:</b> Only allowed when participating in a research directly related to one's study (Please consult with ISSS first) <b>Off-campus:</b> D-2-6 visa holders are allowed to work part time, only with the approval of the Immigration Office. Students must first receive permission from their department, and ISSS will assist with the following procedures. ※ <i>Tutoring and construction work is <b>strictly prohibited</b>.</i>

<b>Housing</b>	Approx. 600,000 KRW per semester (must be paid in a sum total within 2 weeks of arrival)
<b>Meals</b>	350,000 KRW per month ※ Monthly Meal Plans - 30 meals/month: 81,000 KRW - 45 meals/month: 112,500 KRW
<b>Transportation</b>	80,000 KRW per month (local)
<b>Total Living Cost</b>	<b>Approx. 800,000 KRW per month</b>

<b>Information Collection Before Arrival</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Date and Time of Arrival on Campus</b> for accurate dormitory check-ins</li> <li>2. <b>Passport and Visa Copy</b> for submission to immigration office</li> <li>3. <b>Passport sized photo in JPEG</b> for government visa processing system <i>* you must bring a physical copy for alien registration</i></li> <li>4. <b>Tuberculosis Check-Up Report</b> for dormitory</li> </ol>
<b>Orientations</b>	<p>Mandatory sessions for all international students approximately for 3 days the week before courses start.</p> <p>Info on life in Korea/Pohang, course registration, alien registration, housing, transportation, mobile phone/SIM cards, bank accounts, insurance, security &amp; health, etc.</p>
