Step 1: **NOMINATION**

All prospective exchange students must apply first at their home institution to be nominated for the exchange program. Nominations are due by the following dates:

MARCH 15

SEPTEMBER 15

<u>Semester of Exchange</u> Spring

Step 2: APPLICATION

Only nominated students whose eligibility has been confirmed may access Rice University's <u>online</u> exchange application (no hardcopies needed). Applications are due by the following dates:

APRIL 1

Eligibility

- Home institution nomination
- Undergraduate student currently enrolled at a Rice partner institution
- At time of applying, one full academic year already completed at home institution
- Minimum GPA 3.00 on 4.00 scale (or equivalent)
- In good academic and judicial standing
- Demonstrated English language proficiency

Required if the language of instruction in the student's country of origin is not English (even if the language of instruction at the home university is English).

- Minimum acceptable TOEFL iBT score: 100
- Minimum acceptable IELTS score: 7
- Minimum acceptable Duolingo score: 130
