

Research Internship (July 23 – August 17)

- Eligibility: 3rd and 4th year undergraduates and graduate students with proper GPA from any university are eligible for the internship.
- * 2nd year undergraduates can apply under strong recommendation by faculty.
- * All participants of the research internship are eligible for a stipend of up to KRW 800,000 (Approx. USD 800) for 4 weeks.
