About UPM	Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) in Kuala Lumpur is ranked 143 rd QS World Ranking, UPM is a public university, established in 1931. It has 15 faculties, 11 institutes and 2 schools with approximately 24,000 students. The university is located just outside the capital of Kuala Lumpur and is among the elite institutions in the city. UPM is a multidisciplinary university that has 90-years of history, and located strategically within the Multimedia Super Corridor, which is only 10 minutes' drive to Putrajaya and 30 minutes' drive to the Kuala Lumpur City Centre. As one of the largest universities in Malaysia, UPM is also a key-player in contributing to the growth of learned and skilled human capital in the nation. UPM presently has more than 28,000 students enrolled in its 78 bachelor, 7 diploma and 47 postgraduate programmes at the Masters and PhD levels (with more than 250 fields of studies). Except for the diploma programmes which are offered exclusively at UPM's branch campus in Bintulu, Sarawak all other courses are offered at the main campus in Serdang, Selangor.

Visa Requirement

You are required to apply for Electronic Visa Approval Letter (E-VAL) by **yourself** through Education Malaysia Global Services Malaysia (EMGS) website before coming to Malaysia. Please be informed that EMGS will take approximately maximum one month to issue the E-VAL. After receiving the E-VAL, you are required to apply for a Single Entry Visa (SEV) from the Malaysian Embassy/ High Commission in your country before coming to Malaysia. Kindly present the E-VAL to support your visa application to the Malaysian Embassy/ High Commission in your country.

We suggest you to pay the E-VAL payment using credit card directly to EMGS (Account name: Education Malaysia Global Services, Account No: 514057662341). If the payment of E-VAL is made through institution, please submit the receipt via courier to:

Upon arrival, please submit your passport together with payment receipt of UPM processing fee (RM270.00) to Putra International Centre in order to get your visa from Immigration Department.
